### CUA51015 Diploma of Screen and Media (Specialising in make-up services)

At the completion of this qualification the individual will be competent in a broad range of specialised technical skills and practical applications in the field of make-up and/or hair stylist designer for the film, television and entertainment industries. For those already in employment, the course will provide the benchmark concepts and up-skill their knowledge to current day practices for make-up work alone or assisting in coordinating projects within a team environment. To achieve a Diploma of Screen and Media all 15 units must be completed.
